It has been a pleasure to hand out 100% attendance certificates to lots of pupils for last half term. Thank you to all our parents and carers who attended the assemblies. Pupils enjoyed their film event on Friday afternoon.

Our current whole school attendance stands at 93.8% which is significantly below the national expectation of 96%. Last year we ended the year in a great position and I would hope that we can increase our percentage as the year goes on. The research shows that regular school attendance correlates with achieving good exam results both at KS2 and at GCSE. We would really value your support in getting pupils to school every day and on time so that they can achieve their potential.

Unfortunately, we may find ourselves having to go to court for prosecution where families continue to fall below 90% attendance. This is never the approach that we wish to take and would much prefer to celebrate and reward pupils who come to school regularly.

Our junior leadership team will soon be launching another 100% challenge across 4 weeks for pupils in Y1-Y6. Look out for their challenge coming soon!
