- ✓ Capacity


Phonics- (Phase 1 – Foundations of Phonics)

Pupils will begin to understand rhyme and alliteration, how to identify rhyming words in songs and phonic activities, learn words that have the same initial sound.

Expressive Art

The children will be able to:
